

Guidelines for writing your article

The conference proceedings volume will be written in LaTeX. Thus we provide you with an editor file `article_yourname.tex`. Note, it contains no header, so it cannot be compiled by LaTeX.

The editor file

- Open the file `article_yourname.tex` in an editor.
- Lines beginning with `%%` are remarks and should be left unchanged.
- Lines beginning with `%` are for optional use.
- Overwrite the capital letters with your corresponding entries and text.
- Headlines for sections can be generated by the command `\section{HEADLINE}` and for subsections by `\subsection{HEADLINE}`.
- To label objects (headlines, pictures, tabulations, formulas, etc.) use the command `\label{KEYWORD}` directly behind the object.
- To make reference to a labeled object use the command `\ref{KEYWORD}`.
- For including graphics please use the given picture environment in the editor file at the particular point where you want to include the graphic (you have to remove `%` in each line). Graphics can be included as ps,pdf or eps files. The command `\caption{CAPTION OF GRAPHIC}` allocates a caption to the graphics.

- For including tabulations please use the given table environment from the editor file at the particular point where you want to include the tabulations (you have to remove % in each line). You can also include tabulars created with Excel or OpenOffice as a pdf-graphic (see point before). The command `\caption{CAPTION OF TABULATIONS}` allocates a caption to the graphics.
- Please use the given bibliography styles for books and articles of journals by overwriting the capital letters.
- To cite bibliography items use the command `\cite[p. XX]{KEYWORD1}`. The part `[p. XX]` is optional.
- You can use `\N`, `\Z`, `\Q`, `\R` and `\C` for printing the symbols of the sets of natural numbers, integers, rational numbers, real numbers and complex numbers.
